What does the course cover?

The syllabus covers the main parts of UK and European Union legislation for environmental protection, energy efficiency, and management and control of environmental risk, including:

- Waste minimisation strategies

- Control of pollution

How is the course assessed?

Understanding of the 'Management of environmental risk' (Unit ED1) is assessed by a single written examination.

Application of environmental risk theory and practice (ED2) is assessed by a workplace-based project, designed to further test knowledge and understanding acquired from the ED1 syllabus.
